A Finance Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Monday, May 11, 2009. Chairman Terry Clark called the meeting to order at 7:00am.

Roll call was answered by Committee Members Terry Clark and Karen Good. Village President Ron Kingery, Trustees Matt Bernius and Iris Dicks, and Village employee Sue Perrine were also present.

Each line item of the budget continued to be reviewed. There was discussion about the Route 133 bridge project. President Kingery will call Jim Crane, Douglas County engineer, and Doug Delong, Moultrie County engineer, for their suggestions / feedback about the bridge projects. Discussions also included the heat in the sewer building and any changes that can be made, the sewer valve and gate that needs repair, Arthur Farm Pride wanting to hook onto the Village's sewer system, purchasing vs. renting a tractor, the state of the Village's generators, a mower for the Sewer Department, continuing to replace water meters, and planning to replace storm sewers.


