A Street and Alley Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Monday, July 27, 2009. Chairman Darrell Duzan called the meeting to order at 6:20pm.

Roll call was answered by Committee Members Darrell Duzan and Karen Good. Village employee Jim Watkins and Cover-All representative Del Althoff were also present.

D. Althoff showed pictures of different building styles, sizes, and materials. There was discussion about the differences of two 20' buildings versus one 40' building. The bigger building will cost about \$700 more, but there will be costs savings in other areas. Clearance for trucks, adding on if needed, budget, and appropriations was discussed.

The vendor will install the building on the Village's concrete blocks. The size of the blocks and the thickness of the concrete floor were discussed.

There was a brief recess to drive to the potential building site between the Street Department shed and Water Department plant.

Different placements were discussed and measured, as well as drainage and guttering, using the dirt from the old railroad as a wall support, and taking out the old salt storage to use some of that space.

Chairman Duzan adjourned the meeting at 7:14pm.
