A public hearing meeting regarding the potential sale of the water and wastewater utilities of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Arthur, Illinois, was held on Monday, February 22, 2016, in the Village Community Room. Roll call was not taken; however, Trustees present were T. Clark, P. Pearce, J. Kuhns, D. Tiffan, and J. Aikman.

Village President Matt Bernius called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Approximately 150 residents were in attendance.

Consultant Gerry Hartman presented information regarding the status of the Village's water and wastewater systems and his recommendation to sell the systems.

Questions from the public were answered by President Bernius, G. Hartman, and Craig Blanchette and Bob Ervin from Aqua Illinois.

Question topics included:

- What repairs need to be done to the Village's systems
- Village storm water during heavy rains
- Aqua's investors and the profit earned
- Prioritizing projects
- Options and costs for the Village to keep the systems and repair them

President Bernius adjourned the meeting at 9:17pm.
