A Police Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Monday, June 6, 2011, in the Village Board Room. Village President Matt Bernius called the meeting to order at 6:02pm.

Roll call was answered by Village President Matt Bernius and Committee Member Iris Dicks. Committee Member Dave Tiffan arrived at 6:18pm. Also present were Trustees Terry Clark and Larry Miller and Police Chief Mike Goodman.

Chief M. Goodman reviewed some specifics regarding the K9 unit and vehicle. Discussion items included the donations requested and received last year, the overtime paid for the unit, expenses for the unit, future costs, and what other units are in the area. Research is being done regarding requirements and future requirements / mandates for the unit, i.e. kennel time. President Bernius stated once further research is finished another meeting should be scheduled.

Chief Goodman reviewed the four full-time officers and the part-time officers and their time usage. Sergeant Hansen manages most of the scheduling for the department. He explained the Department's comp time and overtime. The furlough timeline of one officer was discussed.

Some officers will need new protective vests. Chief Goodman is gathering figures and will present everything when he has it.
