
A meeting of the Arthur Board of Zoning Appeals was held at the Village Council Building at 5:05 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, 2009, with the following members present: Kerry Pate, Royal Beals, Duane Hopkins and James Yoder. Also present were Village Attorney Bob Crossman and Petitioner Arthur Methodist Church, by Bob Doan and Bill Singer.

The variance requests that the existing Church sign be replaced with a 4.0' x 6.5' lighted digital sign standing less than 8.0' tall on the site of the existing sign at Illinois and Hickory Streets, in the Village of Arthur, Illinois corporate limits.

After presentation of information and discussion and questions from Board members, no objections on file and none made at the open hearing, it was moved and seconded to recommend approval of the variance request. Motion carried by a vote of 4 aye, 0 opposed and 3 absent.
