
A Police Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Monday, December 11, 2017. Chairman Dave Tiffan called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Roll call was answered by Committee Members Dave Tiffan, Tyrel Ledbetter, Rod Randall and Duane Hopkins, Citizen Representative. Chief Michael Goodman, Village Trustee Matt Bernius and Tim Shadwell were also present as visitors.

Committee Chairman, Dave Tiffan, invited Chief Goodman to present information under New Business Items, Discussion on hiring new Part-time police officer. Chief Goodman presented information to the Committee recommending a candidate for consideration. The candidate, Tim Shadwell, was recommended to be hired, to fill the position with the Police Department, as a part-time Police Officer. Tim Shadwell was present, to meet Committee Members, and to answer any questions that they might have. The recommendation included information requesting that Shadwell be presented to the Village Board of Trustees, at their next regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, December 18, 2017, and that a motion to hire Shadwell be made at that time, at a starting salary of \$16.50 per hour. Effective January 1, 2018.

Committee Chairman, Dave Tiffan, invited committee members and visitors to present information and to lead a general discussion with Committee Members, regarding the current state of training, for police officers, state wide.

Tyrel Ledbetter made a motion to adjourn; Dave Tiffan seconded. Committee Chair, Dave Tiffan adjourned the meeting at 6:47 p.m.
