- M. Bernius made a motion to enter Executive Session to set a price for the sale of Village-owned railroad right-of-way property. C. Miller seconded. All Trustees voted YEA. Executive Session (5 ILCS 120/2(c)(6).) The setting of a price for sale or lease of property owned by the public body.
