A Street and Alley Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Monday, July 25, 2011, in the Village Board Room. Chairman Larry Miller called the meeting to order at 7:30am.

Roll call was answered by Committee Members Larry Miller and JD Kuhns. Also present were Village Trustees Terry Clark and Iris Dicks.

There was discussion regarding plantings on Village right-of-way. The roots of most perennials are too deep and cause problems in water and sewer lines, especially trees, and when shrubs are planted, they have to be trimmed. Citizens need to be educated about what the problems and the Village ordinances and policies are. The current ordinance needs to be reviewed and enforced. It will be publicized to make citizens aware and to allow for feedback.

There was discussion regarding the sidewalks on South Ash Street, taking out the sidewalk on the east side of the block south of the grade school since there is a good sidewalk on the west side. The consensus was to take out the sidewalk on the west side of Peggy Harmon's house and talk with the other homeowners south of her to get their feedback.

If work on South Ash Street is not done, there might be enough money left to fix some more of the alley between the 200 block of South Vine and South Walnut Streets.

Chairman Miller adjourned the meeting at 7:56am.
