Capital Improvement Plan Implementation

Sewer and Manhole Rehabilitation

The Village of Arthur, Illinois recently started a sewer lining project involving Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) Lining and manhole rehabilitation. The project encompasses approximately 48,000 lineal feet of 6" - 15" CIPP sanitary sewer lining and 1,685 vertical feet of manhole rehabilitation. Funding for this project was provided by a low interest loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Water Pollution Control Loan Program (WPCLP). The WPCLP is funded by both state and federal sources. The \$1,900,000 loan has an interest rate of 1.50% and will be repaid over 20 years. Once complete, the sewer and manhole lining will prevent leaks and provide a cost effective sewer service while also lowering the costs of treating extra wastewater.
